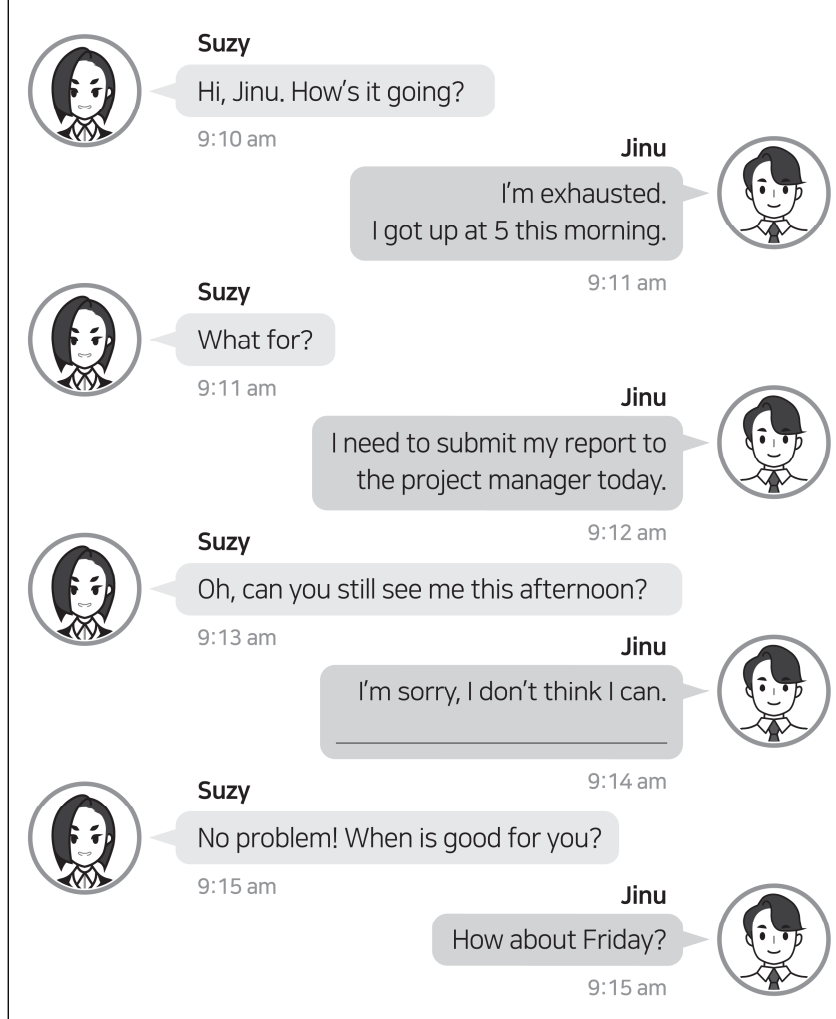

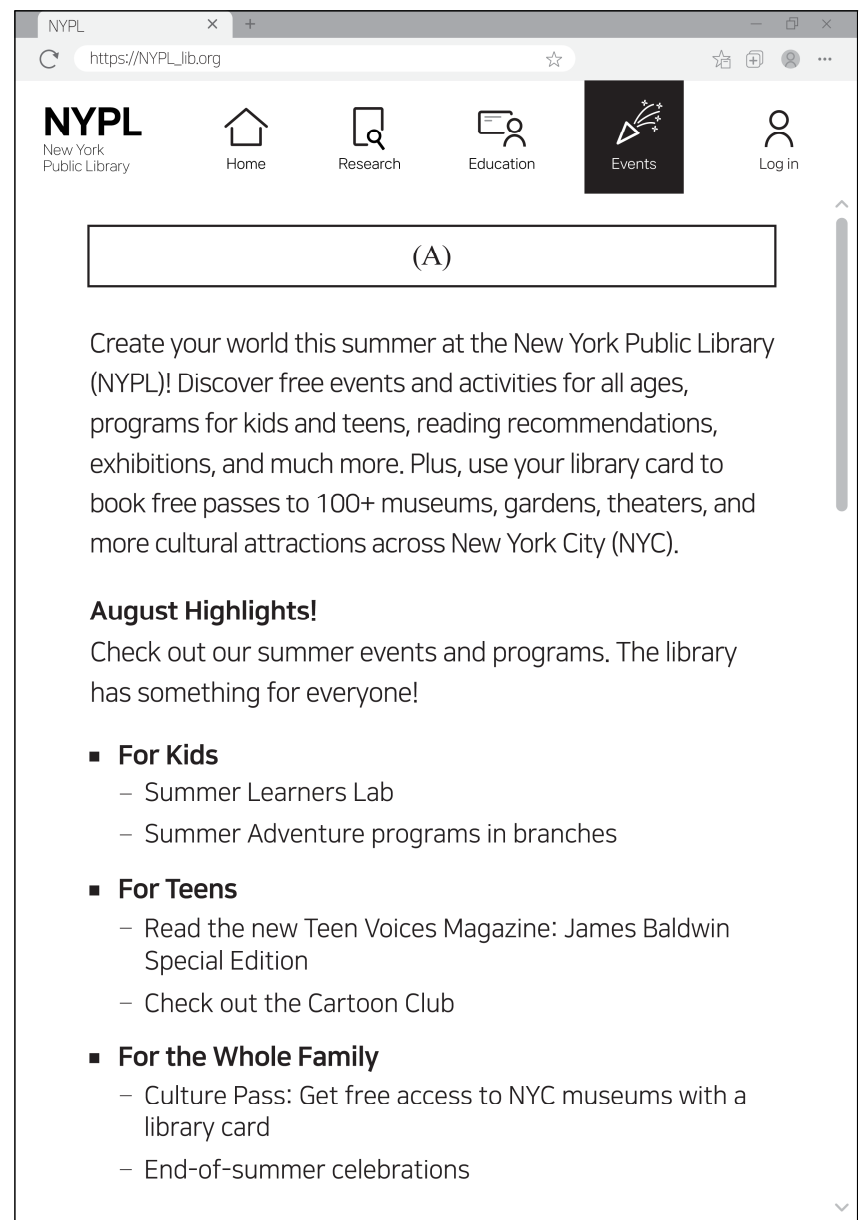

Sound, just like the availability of nesting materials or food sources, plays an important role in ecosystems. (①) Activities such as finding desirable habitat and mates, avoiding predators, protecting young, and establishing territories all depend on the acoustical environment. (②) To continue these activities, animals are forced to adapt to increasing noise levels. (③) For example, research shows that males of at least one frog species are adapting to traffic noise by calling at a higher pitch. (④) Human-caused noise has caused similar changes in multiple bird species, as well as squirrels and bats.
